Raveia totaled 18 points in Monmouth's first three games against Howard, Duquesne and Manhattan. In the Hawk's season opening win against Manhattan, the senior attacker scored five goals on six total shots. She was also 3-of-4 in free position goals, as well as causing two turnovers in the loss against Duquesne.

Defensive Player of the Week

Coffey had a breakthrough performance to begin her sophomore campaign and helped the Bobcats begin the season 1-0 with a 10-9 victory over Manhattan. She had a career-high seven caused turnovers and eight ground balls, ranking her first in the NEC. She also added two draw controls.

Brennan had three of Monmouth's 15 goals against Duquesne, including the first goal of the second half to get the Hawks within two goals.
