Quinnipiac (23-8, 15-3 NEC)



- Top-seeded Quinnipiac advanced to its second NEC title game with a hard-fought 83-78 win over #4 Long Island in semifinal round action in Hamden, CT on Sunday.
- NEC Player of the Year **Justin Rutty** (Newburgh, NY/Newburgh Free Academy) was unstoppable for the Bobcats, recording his league-leading 16th double-double of the season with 22 points and 16 boards. Junior guard **Deontay Twyman** (Olney, MD/Sherwood (Ball State, Polk CC)) came off the bench to scored 16 points.
- Quinnipiac eclipsed the single-season school record with its 23rd win on Sunday. The Bobcats had won 22 in 1979-80 and 1972-73, both under the legendary Burt Kahn.
- In the quarterfinals, Quinnipiac slipped past Monmouth, 84-75, behind 14 points and 13 rebounds from Rutty, along with 23 points and eights assists from sophomore guard **James Johnson** (Brooklyn, NY/Bishop Loughlin).
- Quinnipiac will face Robert Morris for the second straight year in NEC Tournament play. The Colonials ousted the Bobcats in the 2009 NEC semifinals, 75-48.
- In the lone meeting between the two teams on February 20th, Quinnipiac went on the road to defeat Robert Morris, 87-79.
- Rutty is averaging 18.0 ppg and 14.5 rpg in two NEC Tournament games.
- Johnson is averaging 14.5 ppg and 7.5 apg in tourney play, while Twyman has contributed 13.0 ppg on 61.5 percent shooting from the floor.
- The Bobcats earned their first-ever NEC regular season title in 2009-10, along with the #1 seed and home court advantage in the NEC Tournament, along with a guaranteed spot in the Postseason NIT.
- Quinnipiac is taking part in the NEC playoffs for the fifth year in a row. The Bobcats have reached the NEC semifinals in each of Tom Moore's first three years as head coach.
- Moore was named 2009-10 NEC Coach of the Year.
- The Bobcats are 7-6 in NEC Tournament competition, including 3-0 at home.
- Quinnipiac ranks first in the nation in rebound margin at +9.5 per game. The Bobcats have outrebounded 30-of-31 opponents this season and are on target to break FDU's single-season league record of +9.1 rpg set in 1997-98.
- The Bobcats have now finished over .500 in NEC play in each of the last four seasons.
- Junior forward **Justin Rutty** (Newburgh, NY/Newburgh Free Academy) is the NEC's top rebounder (11.9 rpg; ninth nationally) and paces the circuit with 16 double-doubles (14th nationally). He also ranks eighth with 15.2 ppg.
- Rutty is also third in the nation in offensive rebounding with 4.9 per game.
- Junior forward **James Feldeine** (New York, NY/Cardinal Hayes), a first team All-NEC performer, is the NEC's fourth-leading scorer at 17.1 ppg.
- Rutty has moved up to 15th on the NEC career rebounding chart with 791.
- Feldeine (1,303 points) and Rutty (1,124) have both eclipsed 1,000 career points.

- Robert Morris will look to defend its NEC title on Wednesday. The Colonials advanced to the championship with an 80-62 win over #3 Mount St. Mary's on Sunday.
- NEC Rookie of the Year **Karon Abraham** (Paterson, NJ/Harp Academy) led the Colonials with 19 points, while senior forward **Rob Robinson** (Waldorf, MD/Globe Institute of Technology) chipped in with 14 points.
- Abraham is averaging 18.5 ppg and has hit 7-11 shots (.636) from three-point range in two tourney games.
- The Colonials survived a quarterfinal scare from #7 CCSU on Thursday, pulling away late for a 71-63 win.
- Robert Morris and Mount St. Mary's have now met five straight years in the NEC Tournament with the Colonials holding a 3-2 edge.
- Robert Morris is 6-2 all-time in NEC title games.
- The Colonials fell to Quinnipiac back on February 20th, 87-79. It was the only meeting this season between the two programs.
- Robert Morris bounced Quinnipiac from the NEC Tournament last season with a 75-48 semifinal victory in Moon Township.
- Robert Morris claimed a share of its third straight NEC regular-season championship and seventh overall (nine if 1981-82 and 1982-83 divisional championships are included) with a 15-3 league record.
- Robert Morris and Rider (1992-95) are the only two teams in NEC history to win outright or earn a share of three straight conference regular season crowns.
- The Colonials have won a league-high six NEC titles, with five coming between 1982 and 1992.
- The Colonials are now 72-30 in Rice's three years at the helm of the program.
- Rice's 6-1 (.857) record is the second-best in NEC Tournament history behind Matt Furjanic's 13-2 (.867) mark. Furjanic coached at Robert Morris and won NEC titles in both 1982 and 1983.
- The Colonials are 12-3 at home this season, and with a 9-7 record, are the NEC's only team with a winning record on the road.
- Robert Morris is making its seventh straight NEC Tournament appearance. The Colonials have reached the semifinals five times in that span (2004, 2006, 2008-10).
- Robert Morris is 16-6 all-time in NEC Tournament games at home. The 16 home playoff victories are the most in league history.
- Sunday's semifinal game against the Mount was the eighth straight tournament home game for Robert Morris. The Colonials are 6-2 in that stretch with both losses coming to Mount St. Mary's.
- Robert Morris is 28-19 (.596) all-time in NEC Tournament play. The 28 wins eclipsed FDU's 27 for most in league history.
- Abraham leads the Colonials and is the top freshman scorer in the conference with 13.3 ppg. He paces the NEC in free throw shooting (.871), and ranks second in 3PRG% (.449) and fourth in made three-pointers (2.4/game).
- With 438 points on the year, Abraham has eclipsed former guard Jeremy Chappell's freshman record of 410.
- Robinson was named to the All-NEC second team.
- Senior guard **Mezie Nwigwe** (Hyattsville, MD/High Point), who has established a new RMU record for games played with 129, was tabbed NEC Defensive Player of the Year.
- RMU's balanced attack has eight players averaging between 5.8 ppg and 13.3 ppg. No player is averaging more than 26.7 minutes per game.

Bobcat Rewind

Quinnipiac advanced to its lone NEC title game back in 2002 despite entering the tournament as the #7 seed. The Bobcats knocked off #2 Wagner, 87-78, in the quarterfinals, then ousted #3 UMBC, 75-72, in the semifinals. The championship was an All-Connecticut affair against top-seeded CCSU, which set a league record with 27 victories that season. In front of one of the most charged atmospheres in tournament history, the see-saw battle saw the Bobcats stick with the heavily favored Blue Devils for much of the game behind freshman Rob Monroe's 17 points, but CCSU pulled away in the latter stages for a 78-71 victory.

QU's Season To Remember

Quinnipiac's 23 wins this season under Tom Moore is not only a school record, but ties for sixth on the NEC's all-time single season list. CCSU holds the record with a 27-win season in 2001-02.

Rutty's Run To The Recordbook

Quinnipiac junior forward Justin Rutty already ranks 15th on the NEC career rebounding list with 791. He is on pace to shatter the all-time mark of 1,022 established by CCSU's Ron Robinson (2000-04). With 1,124 points, he can also zero in on becoming the first player in league annals to finish his career with 1,500 points and 1,000 rebounds.

Home Perfection

The Bobcats are a perfect 14-0 at the TD Bank Sports Center in 2009-10. Quinnipiac is looking to become the first NEC team since Monmouth in 2003-04 to run through the season unbeaten at home.

Something's Gotta Give

The 2010 title tilt features the NEC's top scoring unit (Quinnipiac) against the league's second ranked team (Robert Morris) in terms of field goal percentage defense (.410) and three-point percentage defense (.325). Quinnipiac is averaging 74.3 ppg and has scored 80 or more points in four of its last five games. The Colonials have held their last four opponents to 63 or fewer points.

20-Spot

Robert Morris has become the second team in NEC history to post three straight 20-win seasons. Long Island won exactly 20 games each year from 1981-84.

Rice's Run In Perspective

In three seasons under Mike Rice, the Colonials are 46-8 (.852) in NEC play, the best three year stretch in league history in terms of wins and winning percentage.

Colonial Crowning Achievements

Robert Morris is in the midst of a record-setting run. The Colonials now hold the NEC mark for most wins over two (50, 2007-09), three (72, 2007-10), four (89, 2006-10) and five (104, 2005-10) year spans in league history.

Top Dogs

This season marks the third time in the last four years that the top two seeds will meet in the NEC title game. In 2007, top-seeded CCSU defeated #2 Sacred Heart, 74-70. A year ago, #1 seed Robert Morris beat #2 Mount St. Mary's, 48-46. In 14 NEC championship games featuring the two highest seeded teams, the #1 seed has won ten times and the #2 seed four times.

According To Plan

Only three NEC Tournaments - in 1987, 1991 and 1994 - have gone exactly according to seeding. A Quinnipiac win would make it the fourth.

By winning the 1999 NEC Tournament as the #6 seed, Mount St. Mary's became the lowest seeded NEC team to ever win the championship. The Mount also became the first team in NEC history to win the conference crown without having both a winning overall and conference record prior to entering the tournament...In the 26 years since the NEC changed from a two division format, the #1 seed in the tournament has captured the crown 16 times. Teams seeded at #2 have won six tournaments, while two #3 seeds (Monmouth '96 and Monmouth '06), one #4 seed (Mount '08) and one #6 seed (Mount '99) has won the title...While the top seed has won 16 of 26 NEC Tournament championships under the current format, in three of the last five and six of the last 12 seasons, a team other than #1 has walked away with the tournament crown.
