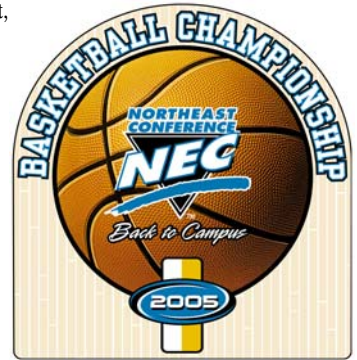

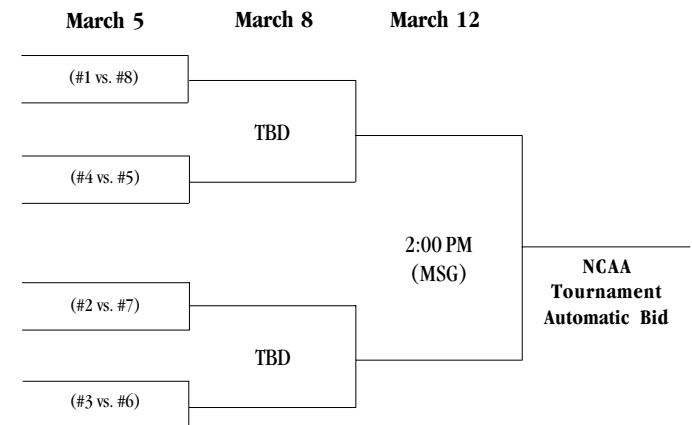

- St. Francis (PA) earns its seventh No. 1 seed after winning its fourth-straight NEC regular season crown.
- SFPA has posted a 34-2 NEC record over the last two seasons.
- The Red Flash have appeared in 11 of the last 12 NEC Tournament Championship Games.
- The Red Flash has won 26 straight NEC Tournament games. Their last loss came in the 1995 NEC Championship game versus Mount St. Mary's (80-61). Ironically, St. Francis (PA) missed the tournament in 2001, finishing 10th in the league standings.
- St. Francis has won eight of the last nine NEC Tournament crowns. Six times the Flash raised the trophy on its home court. The exceptions include: 2000 at Trenton, NJ (Sovereign Bank Arena) and 1999 at Staten Island, NY (Spiro Sports Center).
- SFU had won 31 games in a row versus NEC opponents, including three wins in last season's playoff, however, Quinnipiac stopped the streak with a 76-69 win at Loretto on Jan. 11, 2005.
- Beth Swink became only the second player to lead the NEC in scoring in consecutive seasons since St. Francis (PA)'s Jess Zinobile won back-to-back crowns in 1999 and 2000. Through Feb. 28, Swink ranked fifth in the nation at 22.4 ppg.
- St. Francis (PA) leads the league with a 69.4 scoring average. Sacred Heart is a distant second at 64.2 ppg. Robert Morris is third at 63.2 ppg.
- Second-team all-NEC selection and Defensive Player of the Year Christin Black leads the NEC in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.79-to-1).
- Since winning its first title in 1995, a stretch of 26 tournament games, St. Francis' average margin of victory is 16.0 points, including only three single-digit wins. The closest any team has come to defeating the Flash was two season ago when Long Island fell to SFU, 59-53, in the semifinal round at Fairfield, CT, and last season with Quinnipiac falling, 69-62, in the semis.
- Former St. Francis great Jess Zinobile holds the NEC Tournament record by netting 46 points against LIU in the 2000 tournament and was the only player to reach at least 40 points in a tourney game before Beth Swink poured in 40 points in the quarterfinals versus St. Francis (NY).
- Red Flash superstar Beth Swink was named to the ESPN The Magazine Academic All-America First Team on March 3. She was a second-team member in 2004.
- St. Francis (PA) is currently on an 13-game winning streak (NEC season-high).

- Robert Morris is the NEC Tournament for the first time in five years. The Colonials last appearance was in 2000, eventually falling to No. 1 St. Francis (PA) in the quarterfinals.
- It marks the fourth appearance in the NEC Championship for Robert Morris. The last time that happened was in 1991 when Colonials won their second championship.
- RMU leads the NEC in scoring defense (58.2 ppg); St. Francis (PA) is seventh (65.6 ppg).
- The Colonials have won 20 games for the first time since 1983-84 (23-5).
- RMU tied a school record with 13 NEC wins this season (13-3 in 1987-88).
- Currently, Robert Morris has posted the third best single-season turnaround in NCAA history. RMU posted a 2-24 record versus Division I opponents in 2003-04. This season the Colonials are 20-9 - a difference of 16.5 games. The record of 17 was set by Valparaiso in 2002.
- Sal Buscaglia was named the 2005 NEC Coach of the Year. The fourth Coach of the Year award in Buscaglia's Division I coaching career.
- In just her first season at RMU, Sugieri Monsac became the first NEC Player of the Year for the Colonials. As a matter of fact, RMU had not won a single major award in 18 seasons, including Player, Rookie, Coach or Defensive Player of the Year.
- Monsac currently ranks second in the NEC in scoring (20.1 ppg), first in rebounding (11.6 rpg), 10th in field-goal percentage (.452), 12th in assists (2.93 apg) and first in steals (3.14 spg).
- Arguably the best all-around talent in the NEC, Monsac has hit 15 three-pointers this season. The junior college transfer also has posted a league-best 20 double-doubles.
- Four times this season, Monsac has swiped seven steals in a game.
- On Dec. 4, Monsac collected 23 rebounds versus Quinnipiac.
- DeSheyna Perry, a second-team all-NEC selection this season, ranks eighth in the NEC in scoring (12.2 ppg), 14th in assists (2.82 apg) and sixth in steals (2.18 spg).
- Perry collected career-highs of 30 points, on five three-pointers, and seven steals versus Sacred Heart in the NEC semifinals.
- This season marks for first winning season for the Colonials in all games and NEC play since 1988-89 (16-13, 12-4 NEC).

NEC Women's Basketball Tournament Championship

Tournament Format

Following an 18-game regular season, a newly devised eight-team playoff format has replaced the tournament structure that had been employed by the conference since 1998. All playoff games are played at the home of the higher seed. After the quarterfinals, the teams are reseeded so the highest remaining seed plays the lowest remaining seed in the semifinals. The NEC Women's Tournament Championship Game will commence on Saturday, March 12. The championship game will be televised by MSG-TV in the New York City area and Fox Sports Net Pittsburgh in Central and Western Pennsylvania. The NEC's return to a playoff format comes after an eight-year absence that saw the league's annual postseason tournament contested at one campus site (1999), at a municipal arena (2000-01) and at a single campus site for the quarterfinals and semifinals, followed by the highest remaining seed hosting the championship game (1998, 2002-04). The conference had previously employed a high-seed hosting format from 1991-97, though teams were not reseeded after the quarterfinals as the tournament is currently constructed.

NEC Tournament Tidbits

- The lowest seed to ever win an NEC Tournament was Robert Morris in 1991. The Colonials, who entered the tournament as the number 4 seed, won its second of two NEC crowns under Head Coach Dan Swalga. The '91 Colonials are also the only team to win the tournament and finish the season with a below-500 overall record (13-17).
- This year's title game marks the sixth time in league history that two 20-game winners meet for the NEC Championship. Currently, Robert Morris and St. Francis (PA) are 20-9 overall.
- The #1 seed have played the #3 seed five times in NEC WBB Tournament history. The top seed has a 3-2 record in those contest, including #1 St. Francis (PA)'s win over #3 Monmouth last season. The last time the #3 seed won the NEC title was in 2001 (Long Island). Coincidentally, the Blackbirds beat #1 Mount St. Mary's.
- St. Francis (PA) is playing its 11th NEC Championship Game in the last 12 years.
- St. Francis (PA) has the best tournament winning percentage (.882), most tournament wins (30), most NEC Championship Game appearances and most NEC Tournament Championships (8) of any conference team.
- Mount St. Mary's ranks second to the Red Flash in all the above mentioned categories with a .567 tournament winning percentage, 17 tournament wins and three NEC Championships.
- Ten of the 18 NEC Championships have been won by the top seed, while eight titles have been claimed by the #2 thru #4 seeds.
- St. Francis (PA) won an unprecedented five consecutive NEC Championships from the 1995-96 season through the 1999-2000 campaign. Although the Red Flash missed the NEC Tournament in 2001, they came back in top form in 2002, 2003 and 2004 to claim their sixth, seventh and eighth league crown. St. Francis (PA) heads into tournament action this year on a 26-game tournament winning streak.
- St. Francis (PA)'s Jess Zinobile is the only player in league history to earn Tournament Most Valuable Player honors three times. She won her first award during her rookie campaign in 1997, then was named tourney MVP again in her junior (1999) and senior (2000) seasons.
- Mary Markey of St. Francis (PA) joins Zinobile as the only other multiple NEC Tournament MVP honoree, garnering the award in both 1996 and 1998.
- St. Francis (PA)'s Beth Swink was named NEC Tournament MVP two years ago, after leading the Red Flash to their seventh NEC Championship.
- Only three players have earned both Tournament MVP and Player of the Year accolades in the same season. Monmouth's Linda Wilson was honored with both awards during the league's inaugural season in 1986-87, followed by Mount St. Mary's Susie Rowlyk in 1993-94 and St. Francis (PA)'s Jess Zinobile in 1999-2000.
- Former St. Francis (PA) head coach Jenny Przekwas, who guided the Red Flash to four-consecutive NEC Championships (1995-99), has the most tournament wins in league history with 16. Former Mount St. Mary's head coach Bill Sheahan (1990-98) is second with 14.
- There has been all four times in 18 years of NEC Women's Basketball that the league's leading scorer had gone onto guide her team to the NEC Tournament Championship. St. Francis (PA)'s Jess Zinobile did so twice (1998-99, 1999-00) as did Long Island Kim MacMillian in 2000-01 before SFPA's Beth Swink won both the scoring crown and NEC title last season. This season, Swink again led the NEC in the category.
- The last non-St. Francis (PA) player to win the NEC Tournament MVP award in the last 10 years was LIU's Tamika Dudley in 2001.

NCAA Tournament Appearances

The NEC Tournament champion has received an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament since the 1993-94 season. Mount St. Mary's received NCAA Tournament appearances in 1994 and 1995 and then St. Francis (PA) went on a five-year string and appeared in the NCAA Tournament from 1996-2000. Long Island made its first showing in the NCAA opening round in 2001, before the Red Flash returned to its dominance and moved to the NCAAs the last three seasons. The NEC has yet to win an opening round game. The highest an NEC team has been seeded is #13, which occurred in 1995 when Mount St. Mary's was seeded #13 in the East Region. The NEC has been placed in the East Region five times, Midwest Region three times, the Mideast Region twice and the West Region once, including last year. Here's a breakdown of the NEC's NCAA Tournament results.
